ASUTC PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAM

The one-year Practical Nursing program combines classroom instruction with clinical experience. (Clinical times may vary.) The course of study meets the requirements of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing. A Technical Certificate is offered through this program. After graduation, students are eligible to take the National Council of Licensure Examination (NCLEX) administered by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing to become a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

Classes are attended everyday, Monday thru Friday. Students will attend classes at ASU Technical Center. Later, students will attend clinical at different sites, so dependable transportation is needed.

ASUTC has one fall nursing class starting in August at Jonesboro and two spring classes, one at Marked Tree and one at Jonesboro, starting in January.



Application Process

To be considered for the Practical Nursing program an applicant must complete the following:

Turn in a completed admission application online at www.asun.edu.

Official high school or GED and any post secondary transcripts.

Take the COMPASS and make the minimum requirements; 38 in writing, 83 in reading and 36 in math.

COMPASS Test:

Administered Thursday, at ASUTC in Jonesboro and Fridays at ASUTC in Marked Tree, at 1 PM. Cost is \$30, bring a photo ID. Retest, \$30 and may be taken twice a calendar year with one month in between testing.

Take the NET (Nurse Entrance Test) and make a minimum composite score of 60. May be taken twice in a calendar year with one month in between testing.

NET:

Administered on Thursdays at ASUTC in Jonesboro and Fridays at ASUTC in Marked Tree at 9 AM. Cost is \$30, bring a photo ID,

* Turn in shot records indicating proof of 2 MMRs in a lifetime Tetanus shot within the last 10 years

TB Skin Test, after selection

Application Deadline

August class—June 1st

January class—October 15th

Admission

Final admission is dependent on the outcome of a independent lab drug test at ASUTC.

Practical Nursing applicants convicted of a crime may not be eligible to meet program requirements for selection nor be eligible to take the NCLEX-PN.

Cost
