Often being able to overcome an unexpected monetary crisis can make the difference between a student staying in school or having to drop out to handle the situation.

We know that students who drop out, even when it is planned to be temporary, are less likely to complete their degrees than those who can find a way to overcome a crisis enabling them to stay in school.
