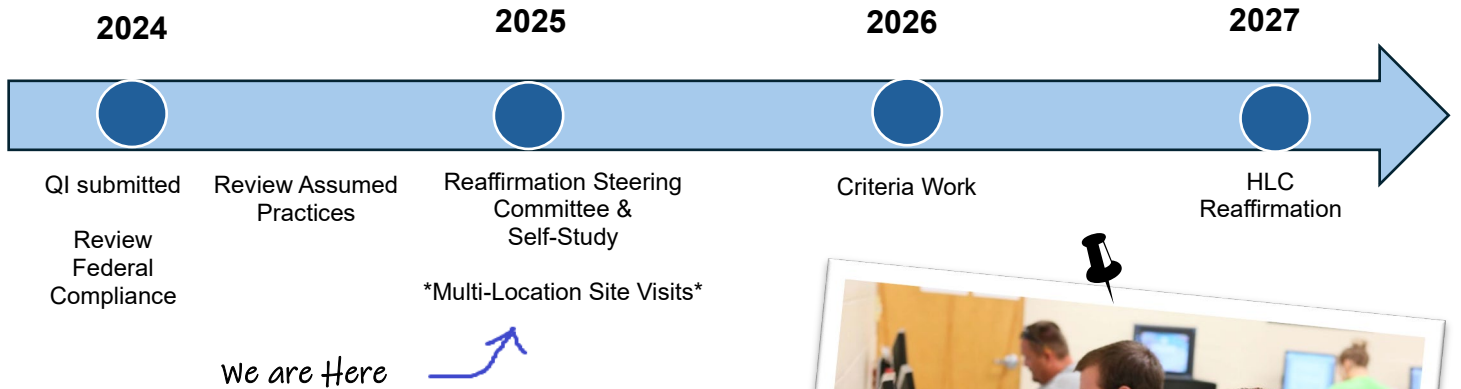

## Focus Area: HLC Multi-Location Site Visit

- In March of this year, ASUN will host a HLC Peer Reviewer who will conduct a multi-location site visit by visiting Bay High School, NEACTC, and Jackson County School District.
- In the past ten years, ASUN has hosted two multi-location site visits. In 2015, HLC visited the Jonesboro campus and Dept. of Corrections - McPherson. In 2019, the Marked Three campus and Dept. of Corrections – Grimes were visited.
- **ASUN has 10 additional locations:** Jonesboro, Marked Tree, McPherson, Grimes, Newport HS, Jackson County SD, Bay HS, Harrisburg HS, Trumann HS, and NEACTC.
- **What is a Multi-Location Site Visit?**
  - Institutions with three or more active locations must undergo a multi-location site visit in Year 3 and Year 8. Institutions that increase their locations may require additional visits.
- **Why does HLC conduct Multi-Location Site Visits?**
  - The U.S. Department of Education requires accreditors (like HLC) to visit “a representative sample of additional locations” at reasonable intervals.
- **What does the Multi-Location Site Visit look like?**
  - The first part of the Multi-Location Site Visit is for the institution to turn in a Multi-Location Site Visit Report 30 days prior to the site visit. The peer reviewer will visit three locations and then end the visit on the main Newport campus.
