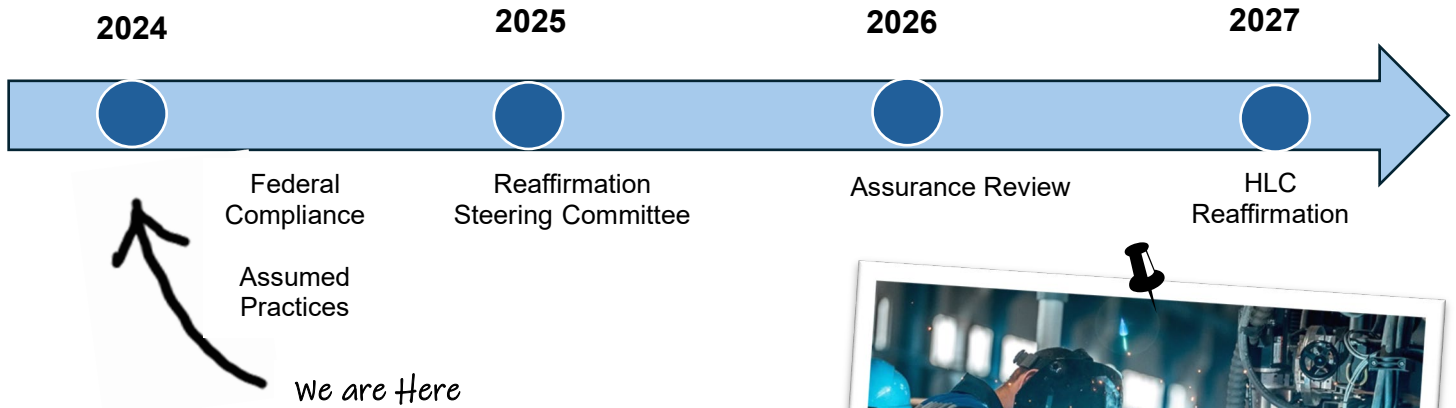

Focus Area: Federal Compliance

Institutions of higher learning that participate in Title IV programs (Federal Financial Aid) need to comply with federal regulations. It is the job of accrediting bodies, such as the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), to ensure that all accredited institutions meet the requirements set by the U.S. Department of Education.
