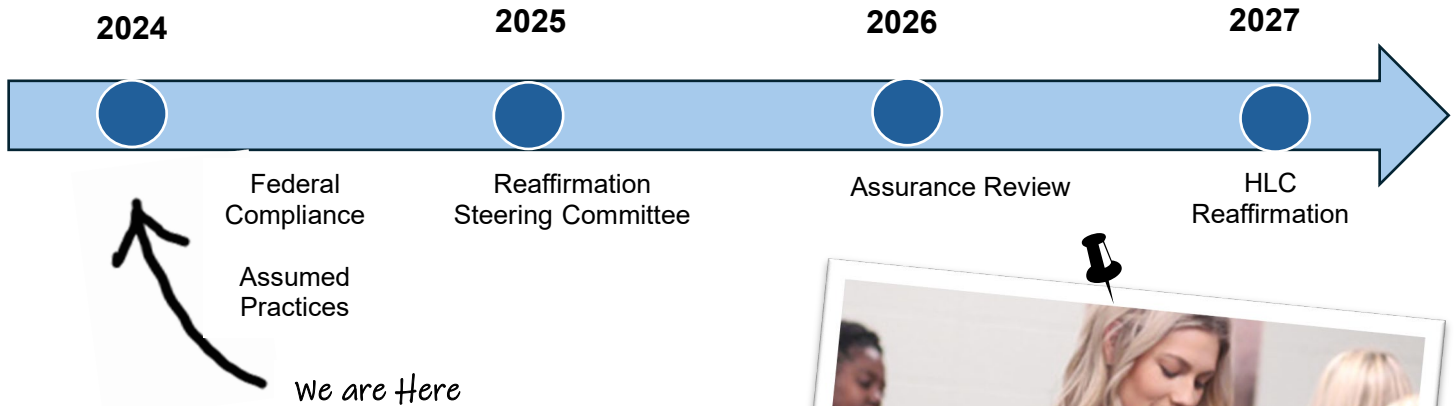

Take-Aways from HLC Conference

- Overall, there has been a positive response to the suggested updates to HLC’s criterions. The “new” Criterion 3, which is a combination of current criterions 3 and 4, has gotten the nickname “super criterion.”
- Continued focus on ensuring quality of distance education courses. HLC presenters specifically emphasized the need to ensure “regularity” when it comes to implementing Regular and Substantive Interaction.
- Several sessions highlighted the importance of incorporating and adding value to program assessment; institutions’ work with program reviews needs to go “beyond” only meeting state requirements.
- Key phrase that was repeated throughout conference sessions held by HLC personnel: “Assessment and Accreditation is about ensuring and demonstrating continuous improvement.”
