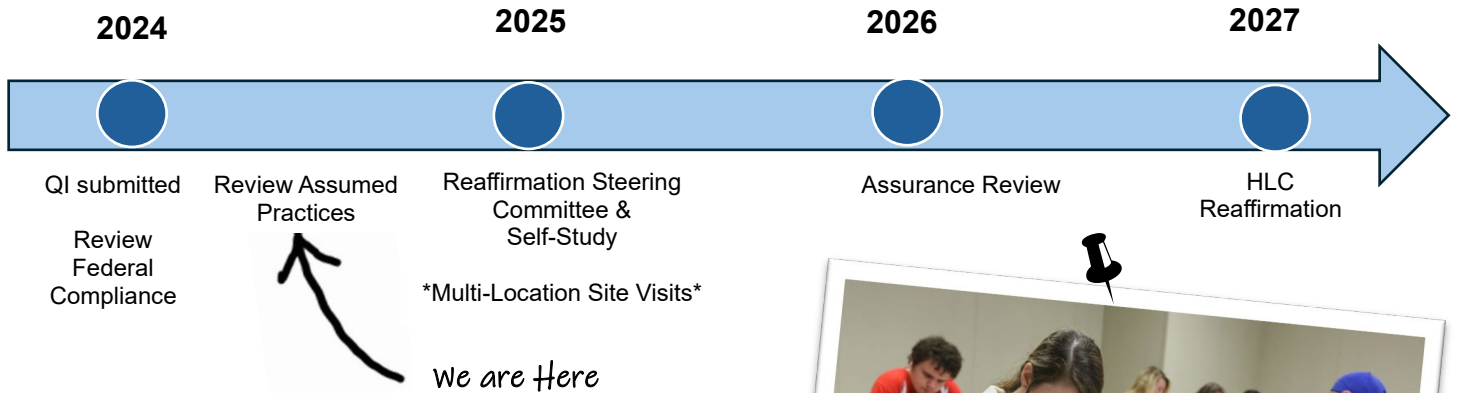

Assessment Updates

- Internal training on assessment across all institutional divisions and departments kicked off last Friday, Sept. 27 and will be ongoing throughout the academic year.
- ADHE has revised its Program Review process by separating program review from program viability and by excluding inactive programs. Some revisions were also made to peer reviewer requirements. Programs not in compliance after AY2025 will be put on notice per state policy.



Accreditation Updates
